FUEL GAS TRAINEE'S REGISTRATION CARD

THINGS TRAINEES SHOULD KNOW:

Fuel Gas Trainee means any person engaged in the process of meeting the registration requirements, who shall work under the supervision of a licensed fuel gas fitter in the repair or installation of inside and outside piping from a gas meter or first stage regulator, and the repair or installation of residential and nonresidential heating equipment systems, hot water heating systems, domestic appliances, or hearth equipment systems utilizing liquefied propane gas or natural gas. (defined by section Mec 102.14)

Mec 306.02 <u>Obligations of Fuel Gas Trainees</u>. Licensed fuel gas fitters shall sponsor as trainees only those individuals who:

- Work under a licensed NH fuel gas fitter who shall sponsor the trainee and oversee his/her
 educational and work experience meeting the requirements for the fuel gas fitting licensing; and
- Hold a currently valid trainee's identification card issued by the board
- Are supervised under the level of direct supervision described in Mec 102.06.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE TRAINEE CHECK LIST:

- Fee made out to the "State of NH Treasury"
- Email must be included o Proof of positive Identification of one of the following:
 - o A. State Driver's License or ID card with photo embossed in the document; or
 - B. Photocopy of the applicant's current passport ID displaying the embossed photo of the applicant; or
 - C. Photocopy of any other type of government ID card that displays the applicants name, date of birth, facial features embossed on the document.
- Apprentice/Trainee Endorsement letter completed and signed by both the applicant and the master and/or gas sponsor
